Devotional	Lisa Chile led our conversation.	
Approval of Minutes	The September meeting minutes were approved.	
Finance Committee and Financial Report	 One proposed change to the Bridge of Promise contract was to revise the annual use fee increase not to exceed amount from 5% to no more than \$100 per month. Offerings as of September are slightly ahead compared to last year at this time, but expenses are significantly over due to the unanticipated mold damage repairs to the office and roof. Finance proposed a stewardship effort to close the remaining difference between the repair costs and offerings, as well as anticipated building maintenance and repairs. Council discussed how to prepare a long-term analysis of potential repairs and maintenance, which could be a combined effort between the Finance and Property committees. Council recommends convening a Stewardship task force. There was a \$5,000 gift for the Sound System, which will be used towards microphones. Wally reviewed the proposed 2025 operating budget which accounts for standard projected increases in salary, benefits, and utilities, as well as maintenance costs and an increase to maintenance reserves. 	
Faith Constitution Changes	There were no additional changes at the October 6 congregational meeting. Council recommends reviewing and updating operation procedures. The next Congregational Meeting to ratify changes to the Constitution is on December 8, 2024 (Constitution requires 60 days between presentation of Constitution amendments, Synod approval, and final vote to ratify changes. There can be no changes once sent to the synod.)	
Bridge of Promise	 Mark provided an update on the Bridge of Promise. Site visit was held in early September. Contract is near final, but pending Bridge of Promise's proof of insurance and liability coverage. Council also recommends reviewing preschool's 	

	coverage as a comparison. Contract will not be signed till these pending items have been addressed. Rebecca Keith and team are reviewing requested tenant improvements.
